Mentor-Mentee Agreement

The following agreement is made between the mentor, mentee and his or her parents. We are voluntarily entering into this mentoring relationship, which we anticipate to be a productive and rewarding experience. To minimize the possibility of confusion, we have agreed to the following:

Objective:

- To have NJTL participants write cohesive college essays under the guidance of Princeton University Mentors.
- An interactive session with students & parents will be held prior to the pairing of mentors & mentees.

Length of Relationship:

- February 2017 through senior year.

Confidentiality:

- All information between the mentee and the mentor will be confidential and only shared with the NJTL of Trenton/ Princeton Student Group.

Meetings:

- For the spring semester of 2017, there will be 5 sessions, all of which both parties are expected to attend.
- Sessions will be centered on relationship building. Mentees will have the opportunity to interact with mentors and learn some basic tools for writing college essays.
- Each Session will last up to 2 hours.
- During summer vacation, when mentors are not at Princeton/in area, pairings must maintain regular contact (every other week) through email, video chat, phone, etc. so as to stay on track with essay.

Expectations:

- It is expected that the mentors will:
 - Provide educational development advice and guidance.
 - Assist in brainstorming essay topics.
 - Advise on college selection for the duration of the application process.
- During the first semester of this program, sessions will be used largely to form mentor-mentee relationships and to learn the basics of how to write college essays, prepare for testing (SAT, ACT, HESSA) and select the right college.
- Essay writing will begin towards the end of junior year, continue over the summer and into senior year.

Additional Agreements:

- This document reflects the agreements that we enter into at this point in time. We understand that the terms of this agreement maybe changed at a future time and we agree to document such changes in writing.
